

REQUEST FOR REVIEW BY CONVICTION INTEGRITY UNIT

The Conviction Integrity Unit ("CIU") reviews claims of wrongful conviction from people who were convicted of crimes in Hennepin County. You may apply for review regardless of whether you were convicted at trial or pleaded guilty.

In order for the CIU to review your case, you must meet these requirements:

- 1. You must have been convicted of a crime that was prosecuted by the Hennepin County Attorney's Office.
- 2. You must present a plausible claim that you are actually innocent or were otherwise wrongfully convicted of the crime charged.
- 3. There must be potential leads to reliable evidence that would support your claim of wrongful conviction.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU APPLY

The CIU is part of the Hennepin County Attorney's Office, which is responsible for prosecuting adult felonies and juvenile crimes in Hennepin County. You should understand that the CIU attorneys represent the State of Minnesota. They cannot serve as your attorney or provide you legal advice, and nothing you communicate to the CIU is covered by attorney-client privilege.

The CIU can, however, cooperate with you or your attorney to investigate your claims of wrongful conviction by gathering evidence that you may not have had access to, testing evidence that may not have been tested, and talking to witnesses who may shed light on your conviction.

If you are currently represented by an attorney, please consult your attorney before you submit this application. The CIU will not communicate with you directly unless your attorney agrees.

The CIU will conduct an initial review of your application as soon as it can. The time it takes to review your application will depend on the CIU's available resources and the number of applications we have received. Your patience is appreciated.

As part of its review, the CIU may contact the people you list in this application to learn more about what they know. The CIU may also contact the original prosecutor in your case, the victim, and witnesses who provided information or may have testified in your case.

After an initial review, if the CIU denies your application for assistance, we will notify you or your attorney, and we will explain the reasons for the denial.

If the CIU accepts your case for a more thorough review, we will cooperate with you or your attorney to fully investigate the basis of your claims. If you do not have an attorney, with your permission, the CIU may attempt to find an attorney who can assist you as the CIU conducts a more thorough review of your application and your claims.

Submitting an application to the CIU does not by itself stop any court deadlines that may apply in your case. It is your responsibility to be aware of and to follow any applicable deadlines if you are separately pursuing post-conviction or other relief.

You should understand that CIU review is not a judicial process. You are not legally entitled to any level of review by the CIU, and you do not have a right to appeal any decision of the CIU.

Send ONLY your completed application to the CIU. <u>Do not send any additional materials</u>. We cannot store additional materials, and we cannot guarantee that documents submitted to the CIU will be returned to you.
