The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: Negligent Fires-Value of Property \$2,500 or More

Charge Description: That on or about May 16, 2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Nouh Omar Elmi, was grossly negligent in causing a fire to burn or get out of control, which fire caused damage to property belonging to victim, and the value of the property damaged was more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On May 16, 2019, several neighbors called 911 to report that Lola's on the Lake, located at 3000 East Calhoun Parkway, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, was on fire. Two engines and one ladder truck from the Minneapolis Fire Department arrived and saw flames engulfing the building and coming out of the roof.

Lola's on the Lake is a large one-story commercial building approximately 45 feet wide and 90 feet long. The building's exterior is stucco covering wood joist framing and has a metal roof. The building was constructed in 1930.

The heaviest damage occurred to the roof, as it had collapsed into the building. The exterior stucco showed little relative damage. The arched openings around the building had steel roll down doors. All of the steel doors were closed and had burns and paint that had melted away from the interior heat. Some of the ceiling in the kitchen remained intact as well as the cooking equipment.

When firefighters first arrived, they noticed two wire mesh garbage cans and one metal drum garbage cans next to the building on the southwest corner. Other trash can setups in the area all had plastic dome lids. The cans next to the building were burned without lids. The roof above the cans was burned and sagging. A flammable liquid detector had a positive hit at the base of the wall behind the cans. Movement and intensity patterns indicated the area or origin was behind the three garbage cans at the base of the south west exterior wall.

Surveillance was recovered from Lola's on the Lake and a neighboring business. At approximately 2:43 a.m., a man, later identified as NOUH OMAR ELMI (Defendant), and a woman approach Lola's from the south and sit at a table closest to the building. Defendant is holding a white bag and takes out a hookah. At approximately 2:57 a.m., Defendant attempts to light the hookah. The video shows the stormy and windy weather, making lighting the coals used for the hookah difficult. Sparks are then seen coming from the top of the hookah, and eventually glowing embers. At around 3:17 a.m., Defendant dumps the embers from the hookah behind the three trash cans on the south west corner of the building. This is a dry area, protected from rain, but not wind. Several other options for disposing coals are readily available.

As Defendant and the woman walk away, surveillance from the neighboring business shows fire activity behind the trash cans. At 3:24 a.m. Defendant returns to the area to look for something before leaving.

As surveillance continues, the flames begin to increase at the base of a column. The columns are hollow and have a separation at the base from the ground. This creates negative air flow, sucking the flame into the space, causing the fire to ignite in the interior of the building, up the interior walls, and into the roof. High winds created constant air flow and movement. The building becomes consumed by fire at 3:42 a.m.

A press release was done in effort to identify the individuals on surveillance. Witness 1 came forward and identified herself as the female on the video. Witness 1 identified Defendant as the male in the videos.

Total estimated loss from the fire is over \$2,000,000.

Defendant is out of custody.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS
