**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated**

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.5(a), 609.17.4(2), 609.19.1, 609.11.9

Maximum Sentence: HALF OF, 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/16/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19245596

Charge Description: That on or about August 16, 2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, DERRICK HOGAN, attempted to cause the death of K.H., a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using or possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Assault-1st Degree-Great Bodily Harm**

Minnesota Statute: 609.221.1, with reference to: 609.221.1, 609.11.5(a), 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 20 YEARS AND/OR \$30,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/16/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19245596

Charge Description: That on or about August 16, 2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, DERRICK HOGAN assaulted victim, K.H., and inflicted great bodily harm, while using or possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On or about August 16, 2019, at approximately 6:00 p.m., officers with the Minneapolis Police Department were dispatched to 3435 Queen Avenue North, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers observed the adult male victim, K.H., lying on the ground in front of the residence bleeding from multiple life threatening gunshot wounds. Officers observed the victim had suffered one gunshot wound to the neck and two gunshot wounds to the chest. The victim told responding officers his father DERRICK HOGAN, the Defendant herein, had shot him. The victim was then transported to the hospital for medical treatment. The victim is currently in the hospital in critical condition.

Officers spoke to adult female witness J.C. J.C. is the victim's mother and mother to nine of Defendant's children. J.C. informed officers Defendant had come over to the residence to drop off school clothes for their children. The victim and Defendant got into a verbal argument in the street. The verbal argument escalated into a physical fight. Defendant then walked over to his parked vehicle and retrieved a small black handgun. Defendant then shot the victim three times. Defendant then drove away from the area in his vehicle and J.C. called 911.

Officers spoke to adult female witness K.A. K.A. is the Defendant's girlfriend. K.A. was in the passenger seat of Defendant's vehicle during the altercation. K.A. informed officers the victim and Defendant got into a physical fight in the street outside the residence. K.A. believed she saw something in the victim's hand that may have been a knife, but she was not sure. Defendant then pulled out a gun and shot the victim three times.

A known eleven year old juvenile witness was identified as being in the back passenger seat of Defendant's vehicle during the incident. The known juvenile witness told officers that he observed his father shoot the victim once while he was standing and twice while the victim was on the ground.

Defendant was apprehended a short distance from the incident. In a post-Miranda statement Defendant told officers the victim and Defendant got into an argument outside the residence. The verbal argument escalated into a physical fight. Defendant believed the victim had a small pocket knife in his hand. Defendant then retrieved a handgun from his vehicle and shot the victim three times with the handgun.

A .380 handgun was located on the floor of Defendant's vehicle.

A knife was never recovered from the victim or the scene. Witness J.C. denied the victim was in possession of a knife during the incident.

Officers spoke to the victim at the hospital. The victim informed officers Defendant and the victim got into a physical fight outside the residence. Defendant's girlfriend K.A. retrieved a handgun from the center console of the vehicle and handed it to Defendant. Defendant then shot the victim three times as the victim attempted to flee.

Defendant is in custody.
