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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Aiding an Offender - Accomplice After the Fact**

Minnesota Statute: 609.495.3, with reference to: 609.495.3

Maximum Sentence: 1/2 statutory maximum for underlying crime

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/09/2018

Charge Description: That on or about 9/9/2018 in, Hennepin County, Minnesota, KEVIN HECHAVARRIA MARTINEZ aided Samuel Yeager, a person KEVIN HECHAVARRIA MARTINEZ knew or had reason to know had committed a criminal act, murder, by destroying or concealing evidence of that crime to wit: taking the firearm from the scene.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On or about September 9, 2018 at approximately 9:40 AM, Minneapolis Police officers received a dispatch to a shooting on the 2600 Block of Emerson Avenue North in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Upon arriving at that location, officers found one male deceased and learned of another male being transported to get emergency medical treatment; it was later learned this male also passed away. Upon an initial canvas, officers learned that the entirety of the altercation that led to the death of these two males is on store surveillance video. Investigators reviewed this video, viewing two males initially enter the store, Male 1 and Male 2, and about a minute later two more males arrive, Male 3 and Male 4.

The video shows the males engaged in a discussion and then Male 3 and Male 4 exit the store and go to the corner where Male 3 dips around the corner of the store briefly. These two males then go back to the store where Male 4 immediately begins to punch Male 2. As this assault is occurring Male 3 holds the store door with one hand and a handgun with the other and he fires his weapon at Male 1. Male 1, in response to being shot, pulls a handgun and gives chase to Male 3. Male 1 appears to fire several shots outside of the store before he falls to the ground, including a shot that kills Male 4. Due to gunshot wounds inflicted by Male 3, Male 1 is transported to the hospital where he is pronounced dead.

Male 2 is viewed leaving the store and taking the weapon that Male 1 used to shoot and kill Male 4. In this video it is clearly seen that Male 1 while hobbled from being hit extends his hand with the firearm in it and Male 2 takes this weapon and runs from the scene.

The video was shown to a person with personal knowledge of Male 2 who immediately identified Male 2 as KEVIN HECHAVARRIA MARTINEZ, the Defendant. This person also indicated that the Defendant is a known associate of Male 1.

The State is seeking an upward departure in this incident due to numerous other community members, including small children, being present at that location of the shooting.

Defendant is currently out of custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
