The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Flee Peace Officer - Motor Vehicle or Subsequently by Other Means-Results in Death

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.4(a), with reference to: 609.487.4(a)

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS AND/OR \$80,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/01/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19122672

Charge Description: That on or about May 1, 2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, TREVON XAVIER MIGUEL MCMORRIS while fleeing a peace officer in a motor vehicle, caused the death of J.S.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On May 1, 2019, Minneapolis officers on routine patrol responded to a call of three suspicious vehicles making exchanges with one another in front of 3330 Aldrich Avenue North, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Officers arrived at the address in a marked squad car and saw a grey sedan and two red SUVs, one being a Dodge Durango. Officers approached the Durango. The driver's side window was open and officers could smell a very strong odor of marijuana coming from the car. The driver, later identified as TREVON XAVIER MIGUEL MCMORRIS (DEFENDANT), had glossy, bloodshot eyes. Officers obtained DEFENDANT'S information and returned to their squad car to run routine checks.

Other officers arrived and were speaking with the driver of the car parked ahead of DEFENDANT. While officers were in the car running checks, DEFENDANT started the car and drove away at a high rate of speed, nearly striking the officer speaking with the other driver.

DEFENDANT fled north on Aldrich and crashed into a dark sedan traveling westbound on 36th Avenue North before hitting another parked car. Officers identified the driver of the dark sedan as victim J.S. (Victim), who was unconscious and pinned inside the vehicle. Officers removed Victim from the car but could not find a pulse. An ambulance transported Victim to North Memorial Hospital, where he was pronounced dead.

Officers searched DEFENDANT's car and found a multiple bags containing suspected crack/cocaine underneath the driver's floor mat. Officers pulled the floor mat further and found a loaded Taurus .22 caliber semi-automatic handgun with a live round in the chamber. Officers also located suspected marijuana and a small scale. DEFENDANT had a large amount of cash in his pockets. Confirmation testing on the drugs is pending.

DEFENDANT has an extended history of traffic violations. On April 4, 2019, DEFENDANT was convicted of Fleeing Police in a Motor Vehicle.

DEFENDANT is in custody.
