The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.5(a), 609.19.1, 609.11.9

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/28/2019

Charge Description: That on or about 11/28/2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Randall Jermaine Watkins, caused the death of Victim 1, a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using and/or possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On or about November 28, 2019, officers from the Minneapolis Police Department were dispatched to a 911 call involving a domestic in progress which turned into a shooting call at 2653 James Avenue North, in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, State of Minnesota.

Upon arrival at the residence, officers observed an adult male later identified as RANDALL JERMAINE WATKINS (DOB: 11/12/1978), Defendant herein, at the door to the residence before coming outside and being taken into custody by officers.

Upon entering the residence, officers observed an adult female who was later identified as R.B.G. (DOB: 8/7/1992), Victim 1, laying on her back in the doorway between the kitchen and dining room of the home. Victim 1 was bleeding from what appeared to be a gunshot wound to her left side shoulder area. Officers began life-saving measures on Victim 1.

Officers observed a female child later identified as R.M.W. (DOB: 8/8/2017), Victim 2, in the dining room. When asked where her mom was at, Victim 2 said "she's on the floor." Defendant identified Victim 2 as his child.

Victim 1 was transported to the hospital where she was pronounced deceased.

Officers retrieved a firearm from Defendant's person. The firearm was loaded and was seized as evidence.

Officers spoke with a male witness, Witness A, who arrived at the scene, who advised that Victim 1 was his daughter and that she had called him at 10:08 p.m. advising that Defendant had her trapped and would not let her out of the house.

An autopsy was performed and revealed that Victim 1 died as a result of a single gun shot to the left back, as the bullet traveled through the left lung and heart. The bullet was recovered from Victim 1's body.

Officers spoke with witnesses who were familiar with the "tumultuous" relationship of Defendant and Victim 1. They advised officers that Victim 1 had been attempting to get away from Defendant, and had been staying with Victim 2, at her parents' home most recently. Witnesses advised that Defendant had previously beaten Victim 1, giving her two black eyes and other injuries. Witness A advised that he had previously tried to confront Defendant about the injuries to Victim 1, but that Defendant had shot at him, hitting him in the back with a bullet, on the occasion he attempted to do so. Witnesses advised that Defendant had taken all of Victim 1 and Victim 2's clothing and would not give it back. They advised that earlier on November 28, Defendant had called Victim 1 telling her that she could meet him at the house at 9:30 p.m. and could have her "shit" back. Victim 1 had gotten Victim 2 ready and returned to the James Avenue residence to collect their belongings, after which time the shooting occurred.

Defendant declined to speak with officers.

*Please be advised that the State will seek an enhanced sentence in this case due to the presence of the child and any other such grounds as may be noticed as required by the rules.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
