COMPLAINT

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Riot-1st Degree-Death Results-Armed w/Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.71.1, with reference to: 609.71.1, 609.11.5(a), 609.05.1, 609.05.2

Maximum Sentence: 20 YEARS AND/OR \$35,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/14/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20159675

Charge Description: That on or about 6/14/2020, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Zachary Victor Robinson assembled with two or more other persons who disturbed the public peace by intentionally acting with unlawful force or violence to person or property, resulting in the death of Victim 1, and Zachary Victor Robinson was armed with a dangerous weapon.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On 6/14/2020 Minneapolis police responded to the vicinity of 200 West Broadway in Minneapolis for a shooting call. Remarks indicated that multiple people had been shot. Several 911 callers reported the same thing. Upon arrival, police encountered a chaotic scene, with multiple gun shot victims in front of the 4th Street Saloon.

The streets in the area were grid locked with traffic and there were approximately 100 people standing in the middle of the street. Many people were gathered around a black Honda Accord. Police officers observed two gun shot wound victims inside the car, and were attempting to provide aid to these victims. Several individuals were actively and physically interfering with the ability of officers to provide aid to the victims.

Identified males had already been self-transported to Hennepin Healthcare from this series of shootings for treatment of gunshot wound injuries of varying degrees of severity. One of these males (hereinafter "Victim 1") had suffered a fatal gunshot wound to the head, and would later die at the hospital.

Subsequent investigation would reveal that there were at least 100 Discharged Cartridge Casing (DCC's) recovered at the scene and ballistics comparison of the DCC's revealed that 12 different guns were involved.

A confidential informant, "CI," spoke with investigators. According to the CI the shootings were a combination of 3 different incidents. One incident involved a person the CI knows as "Ike." The CI identified a booking photo of an identified individual as "Ike." According to the CI, Ike was robbed inside the Broadway Pub prior to the shooting. The person who robbed Ike was known to go by the nickname of "Skits" and is a member of the Bloods criminal street gang. The CI identified a booking photo of one of the identified males from the Emergency Room at the hospital as "Skits."

Investigators obtained interior surveillance video from the Broadway Pub just prior to the shooting. In the video, "Ike," is observed taking a phone call and going into the restroom. There appeared to be some type of altercation inside the restroom as people who were about to enter suddenly stopped and turned around. A few seconds later, "Ike" was observed being physically thrown out of the restroom, and his shirt was torn. "Ike" then left the bar.

After "Ike" got thrown out of the restroom, three males exited. One of the males has been identified as DESEAN JAMES SOLOMON, DOB 06/24/1990. Another one of the males was wearing a fishing type cap and has not yet been identified. Based upon his distinctive clothing and clear views of his face, the third male was identified as ZACHARY VICTOR ROBINSON, 2/16/1993.

Investigators obtained a substantial amount of other surveillance video of the area surrounding the shooting. One surveillance video showed SOLOMON heading north on 2nd Street North from Broadway, while firing a handgun to the south. By back tracking the video, better images were obtained from inside Broadway Pub prior to the shooting. In these images, it is clear that SOLOMON has a handgun concealed in the front pockets of his hoodie.

In the video, ROBINSON was also in possession of a handgun. However, at this time, no video has been viewed that shows ROBINSON actually firing his gun.

SOLOMON and ROBINSON have extensive criminal histories. SOLOMON has convictions for Aggravated Robbery on 08/01/2008 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-08-54251) and 06/28/2011 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-12-2027), felony Witness Tampering/Bribery from 05/03/2014 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-14-18643), Third Degree Assault from 2018 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-18-21048), and pending charges of First Degree Assault (27-CR-19-31227). SOLOMON is thereby prohibited from using or possessing a firearm or ammunition.

ROBINSON has convictions for First and Second Degree Assault from 10/17/2010 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-10-3128), Felony Domestic Assault from 03/14/2017 (MNCIS No. 27-CR-17-8096), and pending cases that include Second Degree Assault and Felon in Possession of a Firearm (MNCIS No. 27-CR-19-30658), Murder in the Second Degree (MNCIS No. 27-CR-20-15214), and Felon in Possession of a Firearm (MNCIS No. 27-CR-20-9345). ROBINSON is thereby prohibited from using or possessing a firearm or ammunition.

ROBINSON has recently been apprehended in Chicago. SOLOMON's current whereabouts are unknown. The State is seeking a warrant and high bail on both individuals out of concerns for public safety.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
