STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

At 1:58 AM on May 22, 2021, officers responded to the sound of numerous gunshots outside the Monarch nightclub located at 322 1st Avenue North, in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Upon arrival, officers located multiple victims with apparent gunshot wounds. One adult male victim, later identified as C.R.J., was lying unresponsive on the sidewalk near the entry to the club with multiple significant upper-body gunshot wounds. Officers attempted life-saving measures, but C.R.J. was declared dead at the scene. A second adult male victim, later identified as C.B.J., was lying unresponsive near the corner of 1st Avenue and 3rd Street, approximately a half block north of the nightclub with a gunshot wound to his back. Officers attempted life-saving measures, but C.B.J. was declared dead at the scene. Officers encountered seven other victims who were injured by the gunfire while standing at or near the front of Monarch at the time of the shooting, all of whom received commensurate medical care.

Near C.R.J.'s body, officers located and recovered a 9mm semiautomatic handgun and a set of twelve 9mm discharged cartridge casings (DCCs). Just south of that location, officers located a set of ten .40 caliber DCCs.

Officers located one additional gunshot victim, identified as Witness 1, who reported that, at the time of the shooting, she was standing approximately one block south of the Monarch. Witness 1 stated that, at the time of the shooting, she heard gunfire coming from two firearms. She got onto the ground and felt something hit her in the back. Witness 1 later went to the hospital, where she was treated for a small gunshot wound to her back.

Officers collected surveillance video of the area at the time of the shooting. The footage revealed that, prior to the shooting, there were scores of individuals standing or walking on the sidewalk in front of Monarch.

Officers noted that, at 1:58:52 AM, the crowd began to frantically flee the area or duck for cover, except for a single adult male suspect who stood on the sidewalk pointing and firing a handgun directly at an adult male who officers recognized as C.R.J. Officers noted that the suspect had a distinctive appearance and was wearing a white shirt, white pants, and distinctive purple shoes. Officers isolated still images of the shooting suspect from various angles and times, and officers immediately recognized the male from prior encounters as JAWAN CONTRAIL CARROLL, Defendant herein. Officers are aware that Defendant is associated with the "Tre Tres," a violent North Minneapolis street gang.

Officers noted that, during the shooting, Defendant fired a handgun directly in the area where the ten .40 caliber DCCs were recovered.

Officers reviewed the video evidence more extensively and established a timeline of events leading up to the shooting. Prior to the shooting, Defendant and several companions stood on the sidewalk south of Monarch. Two of Defendant's companions are identified as Associate 1 and Associate 2. At approximately 1:57 AM, C.R.J. and several companions appear on the sidewalk, and members of Defendant's group and C.R.J.'s group have verbal exchanges.

Following these verbal exchanges, at 1:58:49 AM, Associate 1 abruptly punches C.R.J. in the right side of the head, causing C.R.J. to reel back. Defendant immediately removes a firearm from his waistband, points it at C.R.J., and, at 1:58:52 AM, begins firing multiple gunshots at C.R.J. As Defendant begins shooting at C.R.J., Defendant was less than five feet from him, and there is a crowd of uninvolved

individuals next to or behind C.R.J. At 1:58:53 AM, C.R.J. begins to run north on the sidewalk away from Defendant and toward the entrance to Monarch as Defendant continues to fire at him. At that time, individuals standing in front of Monarch duck and fall in response to the gunshots, complicating C.R.J.'s flight. Blocked from escape by the crowd congestion, at 1:58:55 AM, C.R.J. stops fleeing Defendant just south of the Monarch entrance, turns his torso, wields a handgun in his right hand, and begins firing back at Defendant. Defendant continues to fire his gun north down the sidewalk at C.R.J. from a distance of approximately twenty feet, and the two men return fire at each other for two seconds. During this time, Defendant is pointing his firearm straight out and directly at C.R.J. and repeatedly firing. During this time, there remains a crowd of uninvolved individuals next to or behind C.R.J. At 1:58:58, C.R.J. abruptly falls to the sidewalk, where he later dies. Defendant flees west through a parking lot, running in a small group which includes Associate 1 and Associate 2.

During the span of the entire shooting, Defendant and only Defendant was shooting a handgun in a northbound direction down the sidewalk. C.R.J.'s gunfire was directed south from his position toward Defendant.

Officers spoke to an eyewitness who was with C.B.J. at the time of the shooting, identified as Witness 2. Witness 2 reported that he and C.B.J. were walking through the area and were not involved with any activities at Monarch. They had walked east through an alley located immediately north of Monarch and stepped onto the sidewalk along 1st Avenue when the gunfire began. C.B.J. began to run north down the sidewalk away from the gunfire when he was struck by a gunshot in the back. He struggled to the corner of 1st Avenue and 3rd Street, where he fell and ultimately died.

Officers reviewed surveillance footage which captured C.B.J. and Witness 2 emerge from the alley just north of Monarch and step onto the sidewalk several seconds before Defendant began shooting at C.R.J. The video footage was consistent with Witness 2's account of the circumstances surrounding C.B.J. flight from the shooting, when he was struck, and when and where he died.

Officers identified each surviving gunshot victim who was located outside of Monarch at the time of the shooting and obtained the following information:

1. L.S. reported that he was standing outside of Monarch when the shooting started, and he was shot three times: once in the right shoulder and twice in the buttocks.
2. D.R.H. reported that she was outside of Monarch when the shooting started, and she suffered a gunshot wound to the lower buttock/right leg.
3. T.L.C. reported that she was outside of Monarch when the shooting started, and she suffered a gunshot wound to her left forearm.
4. D.M.H. reported that she was out in front of Monarch when the shooting started, and she suffered two gunshot wounds to her right calf.
5. D.L.S. reported that he was in front of Monarch when the shooting started, and he suffered a grazing gunshot wound under his right eye.
6. J.R.B. reported that she was standing near the entrance of Monarch facing the door when the shooting started, and she suffered two gunshot wounds to her cheek and neck just below her left ear. The two long and deep wounds evidence a single projectile, traveling within an inch of J.R.B.'s skull.
7. T.T.B. reported that he was standing in front of Monarch when the shooting started. He reported that, as the shooting continued, he ran northbound down 1st Avenue toward 3rd Street. While he was running away, he suffered a gunshot wound to his arm.

Medical records, which the State anticipates will document the seriousness of the injuries suffered by the surviving victims, are pending.

C.R.J. and C.B.J.'s bodies were transported to the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, and separate autopsies were performed.

The Medical Examiner determined that the C.R.J.'s death was caused by multiple gunshot wounds, including two to his chest, and ruled that the manner of his death was homicide. Multiple projectiles were recovered from C.R.J.'s body and inventoried.

The Medical Examiner determined that C.B.J.'s death was caused by a gunshot wound to the upper back and chest and ruled that the manner of his death was homicide.

The Medical Examiner determined that a single projectile entered C.B.J.'s upper back and travelled into his chest, where it was recovered during the autopsy and inventoried.

Officers provided the projectiles which the Medical Examiner recovered from C.R.J.'s and C.B.J.'s bodies to the Minneapolis Crime Lab to conduct a forensic examination. The Crime Lab identified the projectiles recovered from C.R.J.'s body as three fired bullets which were consistent with being fired from a .40 caliber firearm. The Crime Lab identified the projectile recovered from C.B.J.'s body as a fired bullet which also was consistent with being fired from a .40 caliber firearm. Further forensic testing is pending.

After reviewing the video evidence, the physical evidence, and the witness statements and accounting for the timing, direction, and natural trajectory of Defendant's gunfire, officers concluded that Defendant's gunfire resulted in the fatal wounds suffered by C.R.J.; the seven non-fatal wounds suffered by the surviving victims who were standing outside of Monarch; and the fatal wounds suffered by C.B.J., who was shot in the back while trying to run north down the sidewalk as Defendant began firing at C.R.J.

Within several hours of the shooting, investigators learned that Defendant and Associate 1 resided in separate units of a Comfort Inn in Bloomington, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Investigators spoke to the manager of the Comfort Inn, who acknowledged that Defendant and Associate 1 resided there in separate units and were friends. Officers began conducting surveillance on the Comfort Inn, and they noted that two vehicles drove away together and that one of the vehicles was being driven by Associate 2. Officers stopped the vehicle driven by Associate 2. Officers located two other individuals in the vehicle, one of whom was Defendant. Defendant was arrested.

Officers then searched the two units at the Comfort Inn associated with Defendant and Associate 1. In one of the units, officers located a pair of distinctive purple Nike shoes which were an exact match of the pair worn by Defendant at the time of the shooting. The property was collected. Forensic testing is pending.

Soon after officers left the Comfort Inn, at approximately 5:42 PM on May 22, officers received a phone call from an individual who identified himself as Associate 1. Associate 1 called to ask why officers searched his unit at the Comfort Inn. During the call, Associate 1 admitted that he was in downtown Minneapolis when the shooting occurred, admitted being with Defendant at the time, and admitted that he punched C.R.J. after C.R.J. approached him. Associate 1 then claimed that, after punching C.R.J., he heard shots and ran away. When Associate 1 was asked about the purple Nike shoes found in his unit, Defendant stated that they "had nothing to do with me." When officers told Associate 1 that Defendant left the property in his unit, Associate 1 did not deny that the shoes were Defendant's. Associate 1 declined to provide further information or meet with officers.

Officers spoke to an adult witness, identified as Associate 3, who officers knew to be familiar with Defendant and his companions. Associate 3 was shown still images from surveillance video of the shooting, including images of Defendant, Associate 1, and Associate 2. Associate 3 identified all three men in the photographs.

Court records reveal that, at the time of the shooting, Defendant had several pending felony offenses, including cases involving Assault in the Second Degree and Fleeing the Police in a Motor Vehicle.

Further investigation, including extensive forensic testing, is ongoing.

Defendant is in custody.
