The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Criminal Vehicular Homicide - Driver Who Causes Collision Leaves Scene

Minnesota Statute: 609.2112.1(a)(7), with reference to: 609.2112.1(a)

Maximum Sentence: 10 YEARS AND/OR \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/28/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21115052

Charge Description: That on or about May 28, 2021, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, AISSATA LAVONNE DORE did, by operating a motor vehicle, cause a collision that caused the death of Victim, and AISSATA LAVONNE DORE left the scene of that collision.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On 28 May 2021, Minneapolis Police Department officers responded to the intersection of Broadway Avenue West and 26th Avenue North, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota for a report of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle.

Upon arrival, officers discovered a known adult male, Victim herein, on the street. Victim's injuries were consistent with being struck by a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed. Officers located a silver Ford Taurus with obvious and debilitating front end damage approximately 15 feet from Victim's body. Witnesses told officers they saw two females run from the Taurus after it collided with Victim.

Victim was transported via ambulance to Hennepin County Medical Center and declared deceased.

The silver Ford Taurus was registered to AISSATA LAVONNE DORE, Defendant herein. Defendant's phone was synced to her car at the time of the collision and automatically called 911 when the car detected a collision. The 911 operator opened the line to Defendant's phone and heard two females talking outside the vehicle before the line was silent. Neither female talking made any attempt to speak to the 911 operator or report the accident.

Soon after the time of the collision, Defendant reported her car was stolen the night before after she left it unlocked. Defendant also claimed she left her phone and keys in her unlocked car. Officers requested Defendant come to speak to them regarding her car. Defendant failed to show at multiple appointments with officers.

Defendant later presented herself to investigators and admitted the car involved in the collision was hers and she was behind the wheel at the time of the collision. Defendant also admitted she fled from the scene of the collision.

Officers reviewed Milestone surveillance footage near the scene of the collision and could determine that, just prior to the collision, Defendant was traveling at a rate of speed far above the other cars in the vicinity.

Your Complainant is aware Defendant is in custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
