The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Riot-2nd Degree-Armed w/Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.71.2, with reference to: 609.71.2, 609.05.1, 609.05.2

Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/31/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20322979

Charge Description: That on or about 12/31/2020, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, THOMAS WILDER MOSELEY assembled with two or more other persons, disturbed the public peace by intentionally acting with unlawful force or violence to property, and THOMAS WILDER MOSELEY was armed with a dangerous weapon.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On December 31, 2020, officers with the Minneapolis Police Department learned of a planned demonstration in downtown Minneapolis, Hennepin County, State of Minnesota. Postings for the demonstration noted that it was supposed to start at 11:00 pm on December 31, 2020, at Park Avenue and 4th Street. The posting instructed participants to wear black and "mask up." Additionally, the posting declared: "BURN THE PRECINCTS & THE PRISONS!" and "Drop the charges. Free them all! #Fuck12"

Officers began to monitor the group, numbering around 75, as the demonstration began in the Commons Park. Officers observed participants in the group to be wearing black and chanting "A-C-A-B, all cops are bastards." The group marched on the sidewalk and in the road as late-night downtown traffic was still present, including the light rail, headed toward the Hennepin County Juvenile Justice Center and Juvenile Detention Center.

Members of the demonstration were observed lighting off fireworks toward passing motorists and spray-painting graffiti on buildings in the area, including the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office and Hennepin County Juvenile Detention Center. The messages included:

"ACAB"

"DOWN W AMERICA"

"Fuck12"

"Kill all Kops"

"Crimewave 2021"

"AMERICA'S LAST YEAR?"

"DEATH TO AMERICA"

At approximately 11:38 pm, the order was given to officers to move in and detain the group in order to stop further riotous behavior. The group scattered as officers approached. Officers were able to detain approximately half of the group as they fled.

During the course of these detentions and investigation, officers recovered a handgun, knives, three cans containing a suspected wax and fuel substance, a green laser, mace, improvised spike balls, a taser, fireworks, gas masks, body armor, helmets, and 2-way radios. Additionally, it was learned that the group had a designated "emergency medical technician." Individuals detained by officers were processed at the scene and transported to the Hennepin County Jail. Among those individuals were the following who had dangerous weapons while in commission of a riot:

JORDAN PATRICK ABHOLD, Defendant Abhold herein, was detained by officers and found in possession of a loaded .38 special revolver. Defendant Abhold was also found in possession of a radio communication device that appeared to be scanning, ballistic armor, and two speed loaders with ammo. Defendant Abhold was determined to have a permit to carry.

THOMAS WILDER MOESEL, Defendant Moseley herein, was detained by officers and found in possession of a knife. Defendant Moseley is currently charged with felony Damage to Property in 27CR2022304 for damage caused to the Minneapolis Fifth Precinct and felony Possess Dangerous Weapon in a Courthouse in 27CR2022184 for carrying a handgun at the Hennepin County Government Center.

MARC MANUEL HOLLEY, Defendant Holley herein, was detained by officers and found in possession of a knife contained within a sheath on his waistband, a gas mask, zip ties, body armor, 2-way radio, and a water bottle containing a suspected alcoholic substance.

LAURA CHRISTINA GALAVIZ, Defendant Galaviz herein, was detained by officers and found in possession of two knives.

NELSON OSCAR MENDEZ, Defendant Mendez herein, was observed running past an officer shortly after a female had run past the same officer. That female threw a metal tea kettle at the officer, striking the officer in the chest. The officer gave pursuit to Defendant Mendez. The officer grabbed onto Defendant Mendez' backpack, but he pulled away from the officer. Defendant Mendez then appeared to "square up" on the officer as indication he wanted to fight or resist. The officer was able to detain Defendant Mendez and search the backpack. Inside, fireworks, a green laser, a taser, a gas mask, earplugs, and handwarmers were found. A green laser observed being shined by the group of rioters during their march. Your Complainant is aware that green lasers have been used to try to blind officers during past demonstrations.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
