The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On October 15, 2020, law enforcement personnel located THOMAS WILDER MOSELEY, "the Defendant," on the Public Service Level of the Hennepin County Government Center. The Defendant was present as part of a group protesting during a court appearance for the former Minneapolis Police officers involved in the death of George Floyd. Law enforcement was aware that the Defendant had a probable cause pick-up out for causing damage to the Minneapolis Police Department Fifth Precinct building on August 15th. The Defendant has since been charged with felony Criminal Damage to Property (see 27CR2022304) for that conduct. When arrested in the Government Center on October 15th, the Defendant was carrying a loaded Glock handgun in his waistband resulting in an additional charge of Possessing a Dangerous Weapon in a Courthouse (see 27CR2022184).

Following this arrest, officers located the Defendant's pickup truck in the area of 7th Street and 2nd Avenue, City of Minneapolis, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, two blocks from the Government Center. Officers noted the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and observed two red plastic gas containers in the bed of the truck. Officers also saw a black handgun case on the floor behind the front passenger seat. The vehicle was towed to the Minneapolis Impound Lot where a search warrant was executed on the truck.

A search of the truck revealed the following items:

- -Taurus .38 special revolver, including ammunition
- -Kel-Tec 9mm semi-auto pistol
- -Ruger AR 5.556 rifle, including five magazines and 166 rounds of ammunition
- -Savage Arms 775 shotgun, including 12-gauge shotgun shells
- -Smith and Wesson 9mm handgun with loaded magazine and an additional three loaded magazines
- -Speed loader for a revolver
- -Two loaded Glock magazines
- -Loaded 30 round extended magazine
- -Bag of mushrooms, which was later tested by the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and found to be positive for the presence of psilocyn. The weight of the mushrooms was found to be 2.456 grams. This report was issued by the BCA on 1/10/2021.
- -Glass jar containing a white powder, which was later tested by the BCA and found to be positive for cocaine and weighing 0.393 gram. This report was issued by the BCA on 1/10/2021.
- -Suspected marijuana, a sample of which field tested positive for THC and weighed approximately 150 grams in total.
- -Hatchet
- -Crowbar
- -Black bandana
- -Tac pellets
- -Gas mask
- -Spray paint can
- -Bulletproof vest ballistic panel
- -Bullhorn

Officers also executed a search warrant at the Defendant's then residence in Anoka County and found a box for a Kel-Tec 9mm, a box for a Taurus .38 special, a box for a Smith and Wesson 9mm handgun, and a

box for a Ruger 5.56 rifle. An additional Remington rifle with scope and marijuana was recovered during that search as well.

Your Complainant requests an arrest warrant in this matter. The Defendant is presently out on unconditional bail. In the two previously mentioned cases, the Defendant was able to secure unconditional release after the Minnesota Freedom Fund posted \$5,000 cash in addition to a bond that had been previously secured. In a third now-pending case, the Defendant was then charged with Riot in the Second Degree from an event that occurred on December 31, 2020 (see 27CR21121). In that case, the court ordered bail of \$60,000 without conditional release or \$30,000 conditional release. Again, the Minnesota Freedom Fund secured the Defendant's unconditional release from custody after posting \$60,000. After that release, law enforcement was notified that the Defendant, with the assistance of two separate straw buyers, was suspected of attempting to buy a semi-automatic gun from a store in Anoka County on January 7th and January 12th. These incidents remain under investigation. The Defendant's persistent efforts to acquire firearms and continued engagement in criminal conduct especially dangerous to others raises significant concerns for public safety.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
