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**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Possess Ammo/Any Firearm - Conviction or Adjudicated Delinquent for Crime of Violence**

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2), with reference to: 609.11.5(b), 624.713.2(b)

Maximum Sentence: 15 YEARS AND/OR \$30,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22001422

Charge Description: That on or about 3/13/2022, in St. Louis Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO possessed ammunition or a firearm and ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO has been convicted or adjudicated delinquent in this state or elsewhere of a crime of violence for which the sentence or court supervision expired on or after August 1, 1993.

Minimum Sentence: 5 YEARS

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon**

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.11.4, 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 YEARS AND/OR \$4,200-\$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22001422

Charge Description: That on or about 3/13/2022, in St. Louis Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO, assaulted Victim while using a dangerous weapon.

Minimum Sentence: 1 YEAR AND 1 DAY

**COUNT III**

**Charge: Receiving Stolen Property**

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v)

Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22001422

Charge Description: That on or about 3/13/2022, in St. Louis Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO received, possessed, transferred, bought or concealed stolen property or property obtained by robbery, and ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO knew or had reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery, and the property had a value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and the property stolen is a motor vehicle.

**COUNT IV**

**Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer in a Motor Vehicle**

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.3, with reference to: 609.487.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 YEARS AND 1 DAY AND/OR \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22001422

Charge Description: That on or about 3/13/2022, in St. Louis Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO did by means of a motor vehicle, flee or attempt to flee from a peace officer acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, who ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO knew or reasonably should have known was a peace officer.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On March 13, 2022, officers with the St. Louis Park Police Department responded to Kohl's at 8440 Highway 7 in St. Louis Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota. They were responding to reports of shoplifting in progress.

As officers were approaching the area, they were informed that the shoplifters inside of the store were associated with an occupied white GMC Sierra Denali bearing North Dakota license plate 144BHM. Officers ran this license plate, and it came back as stolen. The stolen vehicle notice indicated that a Smith and Wesson .380 firearm had been stolen along with the vehicle.

Officers observed two occupants in the vehicle and decided to box in the suspect vehicle so that it could not flee the area and create a dangerous situation for the public. As officers initially moved into position, the suspect vehicle did not move. The first officer that arrived on scene (herein Victim) drove his squad car behind the suspect vehicle. After his squad car was in position, Victim exited his squad car with his firearm drawn. The driver of the suspect vehicle then put the vehicle in reverse and accelerated the vehicle directly in the direction of Victim and Victim's squad car as Victim was exiting the squad. Victim was able to evade being struck by the suspect vehicle, but the vehicle hit Victim's squad causing significant damage. The suspect vehicle then accelerated forward and struck multiple other squad cars causing damage to the other squads. The suspect vehicle was able to move the squads out of the way and then fled the area.

The suspect vehicle ultimately crashed on Highway 169 near Londonberry Road. The driver of the suspect vehicle was subsequently identified as ANDRES ANTONIO CASTILLO; DOB: 8/30/1995 (herein Defendant). After the crash, Defendant fled on foot and was eventually found hiding in a dumpster. Officers located a Sig Sauer firearm laying on the driver's floorboard area of the vehicle. The firearm had the serial number on it removed. DNA analysis is currently pending on the firearm.

Defendant is prohibited from possessing a firearm due to a prior conviction for a crime of violence. Defendant was convicted of Fifth Degree Controlled Substance Possession in court file 27-CR-13-40018 on December 1, 2015. Defendant was also convicted of Prohibited Person in Possession of a Firearm in court file 27-CR-17-11321 on September 1, 2017.

Defendant is currently in custody.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
