





The BCA Crime Scene Team was requested to process a non-fatal officer involved shooting scene in Bassett Creek Park that involved Khaleel Thompson and four Crystal PD officers. The scene location was on a hilltop inside a Frisbee golf course near hole 11. Medical debris was observed in the grass along with broken glass and plastic, a water bottle and a partial pack of cigarettes. A black cell phone, BB pistol, knife, backpack, two less lethal bean bags, two fired shot shell wads/spacers and white ear buds with apparent blood were the forensic items collected from the hilltop. A broken “Jose Cuervo” bottle, broken syringe, a ring and a “Michelob Golden Light” bottle cap were found inside the backpack which wasn’t wet and didn’t smell of alcohol.



Three MN State Patrol squads (which reportedly arrived after the incident) and Crystal PD squad 208 (reportedly driven by Officer Gomez) were parked near the hilltop. A less lethal shotgun and a rifle were collected from inside squad 208. Additional forensic evidence consisting of an orange less lethal shotgun, two less lethal fired shot shells, one “FC 9mm Luger” jacketed hollow point cartridge and four “FC 9mm Luger” cartridge cases were located near a tree located to the west of the hilltop. This tree was the reported shooting location of Officer Barland and the reloading location of Officer Vang.

Further to the west of the tree were four additional squads. New Hope PD squad 157 and Crystal PD squad 211 (which both reportedly arrived after the incident) were parked behind large foliage. Crystal PD squad 201 (reported shooting location of Officer Elfstrom) was parked with both front doors open near a Frisbee golf hole. Thirteen “FC 9mm Luger” cartridge cases were found in the grass near the passenger side of squad 201. Crystal PD unmarked squad 220 (reported shooting location of Officer Vang) was parked between the Frisbee golf hole and a park bench. Eight “FC 9mm Luger” cartridge cases were located in the grass near the passenger side of squad 220.

One cartridge and 25 cartridge cases, all bearing “FC 9mm Luger” head stamps, were retrieved from the scene.

A park bench was situated south of squads 201 and 220. A wallet with a MN ID of “Kahleel Maleeq Thompson”, \$41.00 in cash and white paper with information was found on the bench. A bottle of “Chic Merlot” Maybelline nail polish, its packaging and a small plastic baggie were found in the grass near the bench. Apparent nail polish was on the concrete pad below the bench.

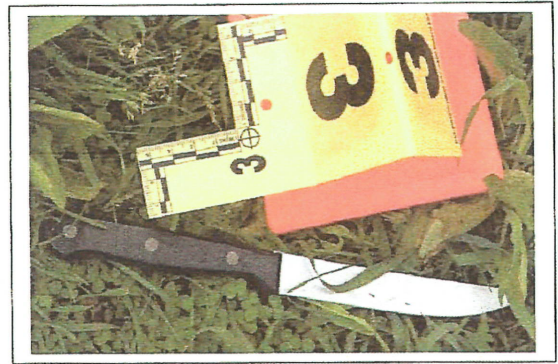





Results of Laboratory Examination:

The questioned paint collected from the Item 2A pistol (Item 2A1) and the Item 2B magazine (Item 2B1) was compared to the Item 31 bottle of nail polish. These three paints were found to be similar in general appearance (dark red/burgundy), microscopic characteristics (stereomicroscope and PLM), chemical composition (FTIR), visible spectra (MSP), chemical solubility, and elemental composition (SEM/EDS). Therefore, the questioned paints could have come from the known bottle of nail polish (**Type 3 Association**). It should be noted; that the analytical techniques used allow for a high degree of discrimination between different paints, however, other paints manufactured to the same specifications would be indistinguishable.

Interpretation:

An association in which items correspond in all measured physical properties, chemical composition and/or microscopic characteristics and share distinctive characteristic(s) that would not be expected to be found in the population of this evidence type. The distinctive characteristics were not sufficient for a Type I Association.

Type III Association: Association with conventional characteristics

An association in which items correspond in all measured physical properties, chemical composition and/or microscopic characteristics and could have originated from the same source. Because it is possible for another sample to be indistinguishable from the submitted evidence, an individual source cannot be determined.

Type IV Association: Association with limitations

An association in which items could not be differentiated based on observed and/or measured properties and/or chemical composition. As compared to the categories above, this type of association has decreased evidential value as a result of items that are more commonly encountered in the relevant population, the inability to perform a complete analysis, limited information, or minor variations observed in the data.

Inconclusive: No conclusion could be reached regarding an association or an elimination between the items.

Dissimilar: The items were dissimilar in physical properties and/or chemical composition, indicating that the items may not have originated from the same source. However, these dissimilarities were insufficient for a definitive Elimination.

Elimination: Items exhibit dissimilarities in one or more of the following: physical properties, chemical composition or microscopic characteristics and, therefore, conclusively did not originate from the same source.
