

HENNEPIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE – WATER PATROL – AIS ENFORCEMENT 2024

HCSO conducted 68 hours of AIS Enforcement at the boat landings around Hennepin County and 4 hours of classroom training.

- 2 – 84D.09.1 - Aquatic Macrophytes – Transport Prohibited
- 1 - 84D.10.4(b) - Water Related Equipment – Fail to remove/open drain plug/other devices while transporting
- 10 - Different types of Trailer Registration Violations

During these enforcement hours, Deputies issued the following verbal warnings

- 20 – 84D.09.1 - Aquatic Macrophytes – Transport Prohibited
- 1 - 84D.10.1 - Water Related Equipment – Place or attempt to place in water w/invasive species attached
- 2 - 84D.10.4(a) - Water Related Equipment – Fail to drain water-related equipment before transport
- 6 - 84D.10.4(b) - Water Related Equipment – Fail to remove/open drain plug/other devices while transporting
- 1 - 84D.108.1(b) - Lake Service Provider – Valid permit not in possession while providing service
- 1 - 84D.108.1(c) - Lake Service Provider – Fail to display service provider permit decal on driver's windshield
