Instructions for completing the Solid Waste Management Fee Report

Please fill in every blank. If you have no activity in a category, please complete it by entering a zero (0).

Reporting month and company information

Please enter your account number for remitting Solid Waste Management Fees. It is the same as your account number for tipping fee billing at Hennepin County facilities. If you do not have an account number leave this item blank; a number will be assigned.

Write the year and the month for which the information is being reported. The Solid Waste Management Fee remittance should be figured for a complete calendar month.

Write the name of your company that is licensed by Hennepin County and for which this report is being prepared.

Hennepin County collection and disposal service information

- 1. Enter the number of mixed municipal solid waste (MSW) customers that your business provided service to during the reporting month. Report both residential and nonresidential customers in the appropriate blanks.
- Enter the amount that was billed to residential and nonresidential MSW customers for MSW service during the reporting month. This amount should not include Solid Waste Management Fees, non-MSW charges, state solid waste management tax, or any other tax or fee.
- 3. Enter the amount of receipts from both residential and nonresidential MSW customers for MSW service during the reporting month. Do not include Solid Waste Management Fees, non-MSW charges, state solid waste management tax, or any other tax or fee.



Computation of the Solid Waste Management Fee

- 4. If you are remitting the Solid Waste Management Fee on a cash basis, enter the amount of receipts for both residential and nonresidential customers as reported in item (3). If you are using an accrual basis, enter the amount of billings for as reported in item (2) for both residential and nonresidential customers.
- 5. Multiply the amounts entered for item (5) by 15.5% (.155) to calculate residential Management Fees and by 21.5% (.215) to calculate nonresidential Management Fees.
- 6. Add residential and nonresidential Management Fees and enter the total amount of Management Fees to be remitted on this line.
- 7. Record any late payment penalties for any Management Fees that were received from customers prior to the month being reported that were not remitted to the County by the due date. Multiply the amount of the late fees by 1.5% (.015) for each month that the Solid Waste Management Fees are late.
- 8. Add the amounts from lines (7) and (8) and record the amount on this line.
