- Transition Services are completely optional. You can choose if you would like to get support at this time or not. There is no penalty for choosing not to receive Transition Services.
- If you choose to receive Transition Services, you will not be required to verify that you are participating in the activities on your Employment Plan. (For example, you do not have to turn in Job Search logs.)
- Transition Services are tailored to your needs. Services may include:
 - o Help with job search, coaching, and career advancement
 - Help to find education and training opportunities
 - Access to various forms of financial help through MFIP Support Services
 - Access to community resources and referrals to other supportive programs
- There are only two eligibility requirements:
 - o You have to complete the MFIP Employment Services Overview if you haven't already done so.
 - o You have to make an Employment Plan with your Counselor if you haven't already done so.
- If your case was sanctioned at the time it closed, you are still eligible to receive Transition Services and Supports.
- As a part of MFIP Transition Services, you will receive a link to complete a short survey about your experience with MFIP Employment Services. You do not need to give your name to complete the survey. Feedback you share used to improve MFIP Employment Services programming.
- If you would like to access Transition Services and Supports or have questions about what options are available to you, contact your MFIP Employment Counselor right away.
