

Relocation assistance

Description

Relocation assistance includes a set of services intended to identify displaced persons, determine needs as related to those displaced, provide relevant information, facilitate delivery of associated services, and ensure expedient processing of relevant notices and claim packages.

Standards and specifications

May include the following:

- Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended (42 U.S.C. 4601 et seq)
- 49 C.F.R Part 24
- Minnesota law including, but not limited to applicable sections as defined under M.S. Chapter 117
- For transportation projects, MnDOT Right-of-Way (R/W) Manual including, but not limited to Chapter 400

Typical services

Project deliverables may include the following:

- Level 1 – Residential relocation assistance and services
- Level 2 – Non-residential relocation assistance and services
