I. Minimum requirements

Some aspects of this work type require that staff completing the work hold a specific license or certification.

II. Description

Natural Resources Services includes the completion of one or more of the services listed below.

A. Rare and endangered species surveys according to MN DNR and federal pre-certifications and standards

B. Sensitive plant and animal species surveys according to MN DNR and federal pre-certifications and standards

C. Land cover classifications/assessments utilizing the MN DNR Ecological Classification System, Minnesota Land Cover Classification System or other methodologies subject to approval of Hennepin County

D. Floristic quality assessments

E. ArcGIS Project creation including digitization and geodatabase creation

F. Natural resources protection, restoration and/or enhancement projects and installation

III. Provided by consultant

Typical deliverables supplied by the consultant and including project requirements may include, but are not limited to the following:

- A. Design specifications, data, reports, maps, and other documentation of the results of the services listed in Section I
- B. Supporting documents used to conduct the services and complete the reports including, but not limited to ArcGIS projects and associated databases
- C. Documentation of required certifications, where applicable
- D. Completion of regulatory reporting requirements, if required
- E. Meeting attendance, as required
- F. Properly trained and certified staff as required by federal and state statutes and regulations and/or Hennepin County policy
- G. Proper equipment necessary for the completion of the assigned task(s).
