**Tuesday, January 28 from 4:15 to 6:15 p.m.**  
**at Golden Valley Library**

## Tree seed art

**Monday, February 24 from 3 to 5 p.m.**  
**at Golden Valley Library**

Join us for this all-ages workshop to create seed art using seeds collected from trees across Hennepin County! Materials will be provided, as well as guidance from Hennepin County staff and local artists. This will be an opportunity to create artwork to bring home and to get to know what trees and plants these seeds come from! This workshop will be held at the Golden Valley Library and fully indoors. Instruction will be in Spanish and English.

## Winter tree identification

**Tuesday, March 18 from 4 to 6 p.m.**  
**at Folwell Park in Minneapolis**

Join us again to learn from experts how to identify common species of trees in the winter. This workshop will introduce skills for winter tree identification using the characteristics still visible in the dormant season as well as introduce some helpful resources for continuing getting to know the species around you. This workshop will be held fully outdoors at Folwell Park in Minneapolis and will involve walking on paved but potentially snowy and icy trails. We will meet in front of the recreation center building next to the parking lot. Warm beverages will be provided.
