

Hennepin County, MN 2024 Point in Time count results

with 2023 comparisons

Every year, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development requires communities to do a census of people experiencing homelessness, in emergency shelter, transitional housing, and unsheltered locations. This year's count took place on January 25, 2024. The count enables communities to evaluate changes in the number of people experiencing homelessness in the community year on year.

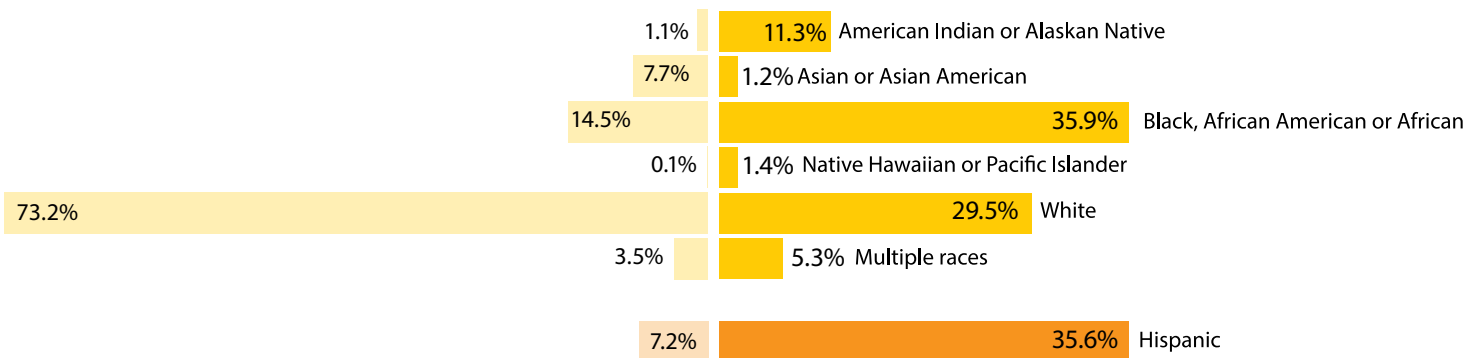
