

# Hennepin County, MN 2025 Point in Time count results

with 2024 comparisons

Every year, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development requires communities to do a census of people experiencing homelessness, in emergency shelter, transitional housing, and unsheltered locations. This year's count took place on January 22, 2025. The count enables communities to evaluate changes in the number of people experiencing homelessness in the community year on year.

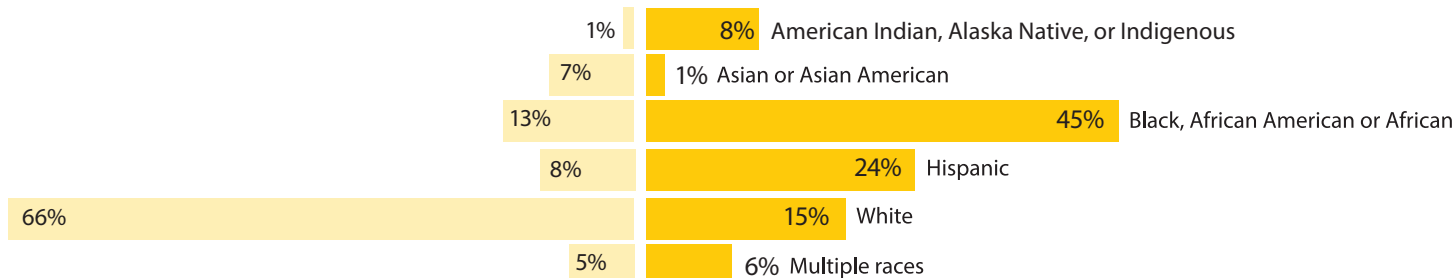

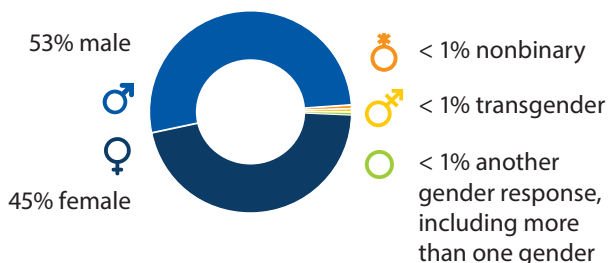

Race categories with fewer than 5 people counted on the 2025 PIT excluded. The American Community Survey does not include a category for "Middle Eastern or North African", but the PIT does. This category is excluded here.
