Agencies attending:

#### **Community Resources**

- **Greater Twin Cities United Way** makes referrals to services that help people with education, financial stability, health, housing, food and more.

#### **Disability Services**

- **Metropolitan Center for Independent Living** provides case management, advocacy, independent living tools, programs and classes, PCA College Service Corps, COVID Community Coordinators for people with disabilities, transitional services and more.

#### **Energy Assistance**

- **Minnesota Department of Commerce – Energy Assistance Program** – Learn about how you can save money and energy and get help paying your energy bills.

#### **Food**

- **Community Emergency Services** includes Meals on Wheels for home-bound seniors and some people with disabilities (pet food may also be delivered monthly), food shelf and food lockers.

#### **Respite Care:**

- **Greater Minneapolis Crisis Nursery:** Overnight residential care for parents to place their newborn to 6-year-old children for up to three nights while they address their crisis.

#### **Transportation**

- **Metro Transit** offers a network of buses, light rail and commuter trains and resources for those who carpool, vanpool, walk or bike.
