Child Services

- Childcare Licensing: Find out how to become a licensed childcare provider.
- **Child Support**:. Learn about how Child Support can help you with child support issues.
- **Family Health** has a family home visiting program to support pregnant, women with new babies and families with young children.

Healthcare

- Child & Teen Check Up helps connect people 21 and younger who receive healthcare benefits through Medical Assistance with health services.
- Hennepin Health gives health care coverage to residents enrolled in a Minnesota health care program.
