## Car Seat Training

On January 1, 2025, the car seat training program C.A.R.S will transition to the Basic Education for Safe Travel (B.E.S.T) program. This training is required for foster parents and Substitute Caregivers who will transport children under the age of 8 years.

The training includes an online curriculum followed by a car seat check by an approved B.E.S.T Facilitator.
