

Approved ID for Marriage Ceremony

Identification Requirements

For a marriage ceremony, you will need to show identification that meets the following criteria:

- Includes full legal name
- Includes date of birth
- Includes a picture
- Is government issued
- Is not expired
- Is in English or is accompanied by a translation into English

Examples of Approved Identification

The following are examples of approved identification that could be used to apply for a marriage ceremony at the Service Centers:

- US or international passport or passport card
- State ID or driver's license from a US state or territory
- Consular identification document from any jurisdiction that bears a photograph of the applicant
- Minnesota or other Tribal Identification Card with security features, date of birth, and picture
- Identification card issued by the U.S. Department of Defense (ie: DD-1173) with date of birth, and picture
