Homes built before 1978 may contain lead-based paint and other hazards.

Every year, hundreds of children in Hennepin County are found to have blood lead levels **high enough to damage their health.**

Lead poisoning is 100% preventable!

Hennepin County has fixed lead hazards in more than 4,500 homes through the lead program.

Other home health hazard resources

Grants and loans may also be available to fix other health hazards in your home like radon, moisture, mold and pests.

If you are a homeowner living with a child who has asthma, you may qualify for an assessment and funding to reduce asthma triggers in the home.

Old windows are the most common source of lead hazards in the home.

Lead exposure from lead-based paint can put young children at risk for:

- Brain and nervous system damage
- Slowed growth and development
- Learning and behavior problems

There is no safe level of lead exposure!

Don't wait to make your home lead safe!

You may qualify for a free home lead assessment and up to \$15,000 to help fix lead hazards in your home, like replacing old windows.

Eligibility requirements:

- Your home or rental property was built before 1978
- A child under the age of six lives at or regularly visits your home or rental property
- Household meets income requirements

How to enroll and what to expect:

We will contact you to schedule an in-home visit to determine if your home is a candidate for the grant program.

If lead is found and you meet eligibility requirements, we'll work with you through the grant process, contractor selection and other steps to make your home lead-safe.
