The Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office Forensic Fellowship Program

Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office serves Hennepin County, Dakota County, Scott County, and referral counties in Minnesota. The salary range for the fellow is approximately \$100,000 a year combined with a desirable benefits package.

Responsibilities include scene investigation under the direction of experienced staff, case analysis, autopsies on medical examiner cases, conference presentations, courtroom testimony, toxicology, forensic anthropology, forensic odontology tutorial, weekly didactics and a special assignment in cardiovascular disease.

The office is accredited by the National Association of Medical Examiners and sponsors an ACGME-accredited fellowship in forensic pathology. The office also employs a death investigation team that is required to be certified by the American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators.

Join a team of eight forensic pathologists who have nationwide influence and play an active leadership role in improving medicolegal death investigation and forensic pathology through committee and board memberships, including:

- National Association of Medical Examiners (NAME)
- American Academy of Forensic Sciences (AAFS)
- College of American Pathologists (CAP)
- American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP)
- Organization of Scientific Area Committees (OSAC-NIST)

Our area of coverage has more than 1.7 million residents and covers approximately 1,500 square miles.

Hennepin County built a new state-of-the-art medical examiner's facility in the western suburb of Minnetonka in 2022. The new facility, which received a 2022 American Institute of Architects Merit Award, was designed to meet the needs of our diverse population and fulfill our vision to serve as a regional center of excellent in forensic science with timely, accurate and compassionate investigation.
