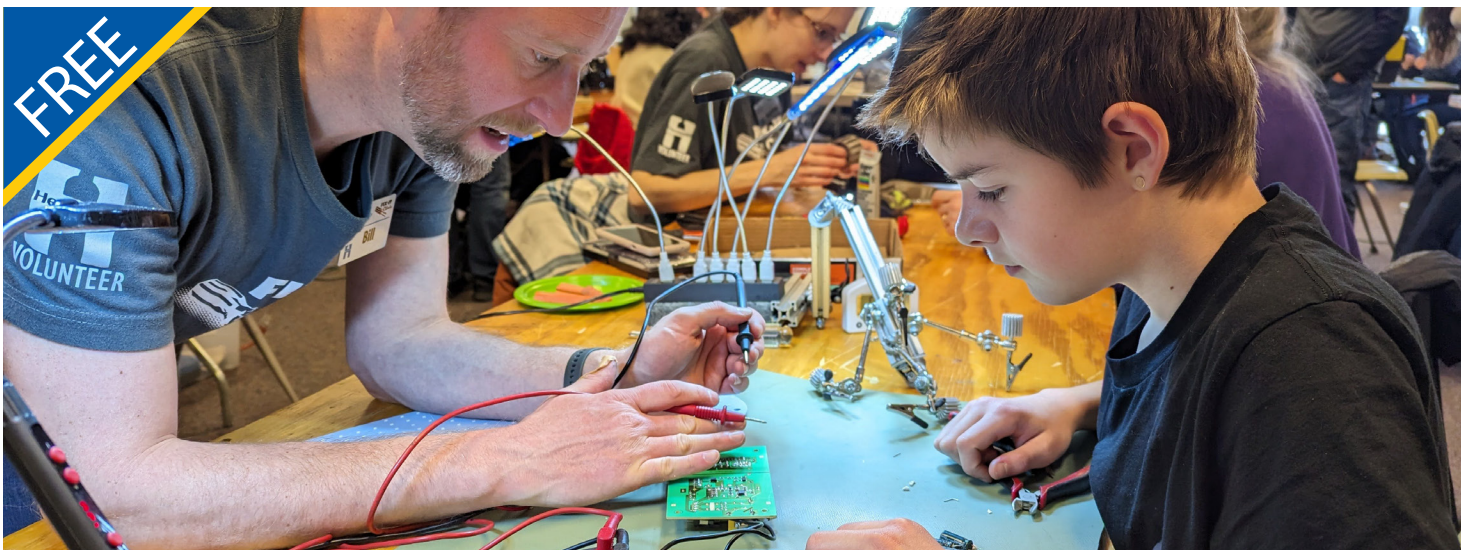
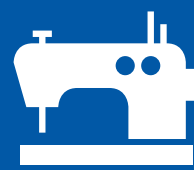




Don't trash it – Fix-It!
