

## Project overview

Hennepin County, in partnership with the City of Minneapolis, plans to reconstruct Cedar Avenue (County Road 152) between Lake Street (County Road 3) and 24th Street East.

The reconstruction work is scheduled to begin in Spring 2026 and be completed in Fall 2027.

## Project engagement

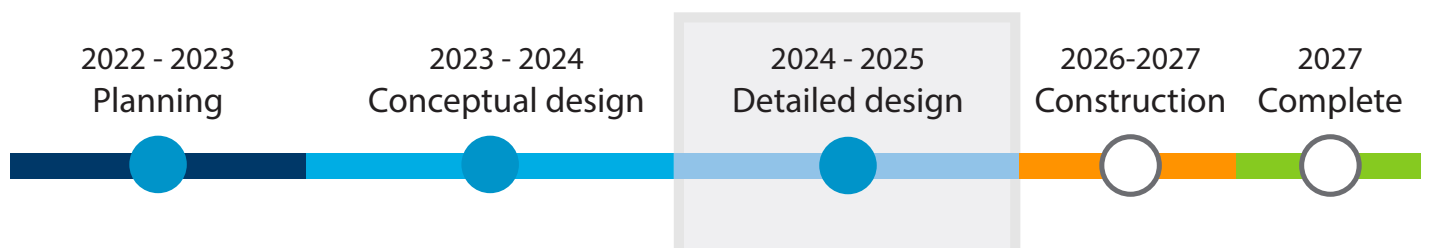
Since 2023, the Cedar Avenue project team has engaged with the community:

- We asked how people use Cedar Avenue today and what they want a reconstructed Cedar Avenue to look like.
- We held listening sessions, focus groups and workshops, and attended community events to build relationships and create an inclusive experience to gain multicultural perspectives.
- To better reach the community, we partnered with community-based organizations in the Phillips neighborhood with the interest, capacity, and expertise in conducting engagement.

## Key design features

The final design for Cedar Avenue is based on the six project goals and feedback from the community throughout the design process.

Improve traffic flow and overall safety using a two-lane road with left turn lanes.

Slow traffic and improve pedestrian safety by adding wider boulevards and medians in select locations.

Add space for bicyclists with a two-way separated bike path between 24th Street and 28th Street (converts to a shared use path between Cedar Field Park and 26th Street.)

Enable more space for people walking and biking by removing parking north of 28th Street.

Prioritize greening and enable efficient rainwater management.
