## Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC)

## A Resolution Requesting the Inclusion of Bicycle Accommodations within the TH-100 Reconstruction Project

**DATE:** Monday, May 10, 1999

**MOTION:** Moved by *John T. Richter*, seconded by *J. Skalbeck*.

Whereas, the Minnesota Department of Transportation (Mn/DOT) is currently designing improvements for the reconstruction of TH-100 from an aging four-lane expressway to a freeway between Glenwood Avenue (CSAH-40) and  $50^{th}$  Avenue North; and

Whereas, TH-100 while being a necessary project to serve vehicular traffic, also by its nature is a major barrier to east-west pedestrian and bicycle movement, and its design elements will have to serve for many years into the future; and,

Whereas, the Hennepin County Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) has discussed options for bicycle accommodations along and across the TH-100 corridor over the last 3 years, the BAC has hosted joint meetings with Mn/DOT and the adjacent cities of Crystal, Golden Valley, and Robbinsdale, and the BAC has developed a proposed bicycle circulation system for the TH-100 corridor; and,

Whereas, these joint meetings plus discussions with other affected cities of Plymouth, New Hope and Minneapolis have identified 36th Avenue North as one of the critical crossings of the TH-100 corridor; and,

Whereas, Mn/DOT has reached the 60 percent design stage for Segment 2 of the corridor which includes the section from Bassett Creek to just south of CSAH-9 (42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North), and includes the new proposed interchange at 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue North that does not currently include bicycle accommodation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hennepin County Bicycle Advisory Committee respectfully requests that the County Board of Commissioners request Mn/DOT to study alternatives for providing bicycle accommodations through the TH-100 /  $36^{th}$  Avenue North Interchange, and that the County Board of Commissioners issue a statement of support for BAC efforts to coordinate other bicycle accommodations and connections within the TH-100 corridor.
