Hennepin County is developing designs to improve safety and access at the intersection of Lake Street (County Road 3) at Cedar Avenue (County Road 152) and the intersections of 42nd Street (County Road 42) at Cedar, 21st, 26th and Nokomis avenues. In May-June 2021, the project team held an online open house and hosted a survey to gather feedback about the project designs.


What we heard about the designs:

1. Lake Street and Cedar Avenue

- + People liked the increased sidewalk space and shorter pedestrian crossings.
- People were concerned that the proposed design did not address the number of lanes on Cedar Avenue.
- Some people had questions about how the proposed design would work with buses.

2. 42nd Street and Cedar Avenue

- + People liked the left-turn lanes to improve safety and reduce traffic back-ups.
- + People liked that people biking on 42nd Street are separated from vehicle traffic through the intersection.
- People were concerned about the signal operations, bus stops, and connections to other bicycle facilities.



3. 42nd Street and 21st Avenue

- + People liked the raised median and the median refuge for people walking and biking across 42nd Street.
- People were concerned that marked crosswalks are not proposed.
- Some people were concerned about truck movements and winter maintenance.

4. 42nd Street and 26th Avenue

- + People liked the raised median and the median refuge for people walking and biking across 42nd Street.
- People were concerned that marked crosswalks and bicycle cut-throughs of the median are not proposed.


5. 42nd Street and Nokomis Avenue


