Lowry Avenue NE reconstruction

County Road 153 in Minneapolis

Hennepin County is planning to reconstruct Lowry Avenue (County Road 153) between Marshall Street (County Road 23) and Johnson Street in Northeast Minneapolis. When complete, the corridor will include a smoother road surface, a shared use path for people walking, biking and rolling, wider boulevards and improved pedestrian safety features. All dates are subject to change.

Phase 1

Eastern section of Lowry Avenue between Washington and Johnson streets.

• **Design**: 2020 to 2023

• **Construction:** 2024 to 2025

As the county begins Phase 1 construction in 2024, we will reach out to corridor area users, business owners and residents to inform them of detours, upcoming work and other project developments.

Phase 2

Western section of Lowry Avenue between Marshall and Washington streets.

• **Design:** 2023 to 2026

Construction: 2026 – 2027

Phase 2 of the project is currently in preliminary design. The Phase 2 design will use feedback from our public engagement efforts and build from the Phase 1 layout features. If you live, work, or travel along Lowry Avenue, you're invited to share feedback as the project team develops the design for future improvements.
