

PROJECT OVERVIEW








Existing roadway street views


OVERVIEW


Currently, Mill Street has no bike or pedestrian facilities. The Excelsior portion of Mill Street has curb and gutter, but the Shorewood portion does not.


EXISTING EXCELSIOR ROADWAY 2ND STREET TO EXCELSIOR CITY LIMITS

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Pathway option 1 street views


OVERVIEW

The majority of option 1 includes pavement resurfacing of Mill Street and the addition of a 10-foot pathway separated from the street by a 6-foot grassy boulevard.

Option 1 section A street view


SECTION A

Section A runs from Holly Lane in Chanhassen to the south end of the Highway 7 bridge in Excelsior. It primarily includes pavement resurfacing of Mill Street and the addition of a 10-foot pathway separated from the street by a 6-foot grassy boulevard.




Option 1 section B street view

Section B runs from just north of Wheeler Drive to 3rd Avenue in Excelsior. To work around existing retaining walls in this section, the grassy boulevard is eliminated and the pathway is increased to 12 feet. This section will also include pavement resurfacing of Mill Street.



Option 1 section C street view

Section C runs from the north end of the Highway 7 bridge to 2nd Street in downtown Excelsior. It primarily includes a 6-foot sidewalk and no grassy boulevard.





Pathway option 2 street views



Option 2 section A street view


SECTION A

Option 2 section B street view

Option 2 section C street view

Section C runs from the north end of the Highway 7 bridge to 2nd Street in downtown Excelsior. It primarily includes a 10-foot sidewalk and no grassy boulevard or bikeable shoulders.
