

Project overview




Hennepin County is working on early designs for reconstructing Osseo Road (County Road 152) between Penn and 49th avenues in Minneapolis



The existing roadway has reached the end of its service life and is due for replacement



Initial design is underway, and construction is anticipated to begin in 2022

Improve roadway and intersection safety




Replace pavement, curbs and gutters



Review traffic signal opportunities to enhance traffic operations










49th Avenue intersection


Osseo Road bridge






North of 47th Avenue intersection






Memorial Drive and Russell Avenue intersections




Victory Memorial Parkway and Grand Rounds Trail intersections




North of 44th Avenue and Penn Avenue intersection





Osseo Road bridge staircase replacement








47TH AVE INTERSECTION ALTERNATIVE


