Curriculum and lesson plans

For elementary students

My County Works activity book

This activity book is designed for elementary students and combines information about local government with art, math and writing practice activities. Different areas of county government feature different activities (for example, math problems in the section on budget). Each section has questions for students to reflect on how they are impacted by county government. The activity book has 20 pages of instructional content.

For middle and high school students

County Solutions lesson series

The County Solutions lesson series teaches middle and high school students about the role of local government through reflecting on their own communities. Students identify a problem in their



community and explore possible solutions, including method of outreach and advocacy. There are two sets of lessons: one for middle schools and one for high schools.

Counties Work game and curriculum

Students can try their hand at running their very own county with the Counties Work game. They play the role of a county official balancing resident needs, proposals, budgets and more. A Spanish translation and vocabulary word glossary are available within the game.

The game also has an <u>extension pack</u> with suggested classroom activities and teaching tools to reinforce the concepts explored in the game.
