

Community Solutions is a nonprofit that leads Built for Zero, a national initiative of more than 100 cities and counties committed to measurably ending homelessness.



#### 1. Homelessness is rare and brief.

This means that the number of people experiencing homelessness at any time does not exceed the community's proven record of housing at least that many people in a month

- 2. Cities and counties are operating off of a full accounting of homelessness at all times.
- 3. The community is working toward equitable systems, starting with a focus on race and ethnicity.
- 4. Finally, all of these achievements are sustained over time, even as local conditions




### **Chronic Progress Comparison**












### Veteran Progress Comparison

# MINNEAPOLIS/HENNEPIN COUNTY ACHIEVES 30% REDUCTION IN CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS BY IMPROVING THEIR SYSTEM

With a focus on race equity, quality improvement, and increased direct service capacity, the community has reduced the number of people experiencing chronic homelessness from 488 to 342 over the last year.




