Program Background



- The Hennepin County Youth Activities Grants (HCYAG) program started in 2009.
- The program provides grants to local governments and partner orgs for youth activities.
- It is funded by the Twins Ballpark sales tax.



Grant Initiatives & Opportunities

Sports Grants

- Play areas (facilities, playgrounds, play spaces)
- Sports equipment
- Arts & Music Grants for arts and music programming and education
- Water Safety Grants
 - Free or reduced-cost swim lesson grants, administered by the USA Swimming Foundation
 - Lifeguard services



Grant Eligibility

- Limited to Local Government Units (LGUs) in Hennepin County:
 - Municipalities (i.e., cities)
 - Watershed districts
 - Park districts
 - School districts
- Partnerships with other local organizations are encouraged

Equipment Grants

The purpose of this grant opportunity is to increase opportunities for youth to participate in sports and recreational activities.

A total of \$135,000 has been allocated for Spring 2025.

Grants up to \$10,000 are available.



Hennepin County 1

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a local government unit (LGU) located in Hennepin County.
- The majority of individuals benefitting from grant funding must reside within Hennepin County.
- The equipment must be used and intended for kids age 18 years or younger, and/or be used by individuals participating in U4-U19 sports.
- Equipment purchased with grant funds must be used for youth athletic or recreational activities that take place in Hennepin County.



Eligibility (cont.)

- Equipment purchased with grant funds must reside and be stored in Hennepin County.
- Equipment purchased with grant funds must be reuseable and not intended for single use or kept by individuals.
- Partner organizations and entities receiving grant funds must be registered with the Minnesota Secretary of State.
- Applicant may submit no more than five applications per RFA. If more than five applications are received, all applications may be considered ineligible and rejected as non-responsive.



Definitions

Term	Definition			
Local Government Unit (LGU)	Municipal districts, public school district, park district, and watershed district located in or operating within Hennepin County.			
Youth athletic activity	Defined in Minnesota State Statute <u>Sec. 121A.38</u> as "any sport or other athletic activity related to competition, practice, or training exercises which is intended for youth athletes and at which a coach or official is present in an official capacity as a coach or official."			
Adaptive sports	A recreational or competitive sport that has either been adapted specifically for persons with a disability or created specifically for persons with a disability			
Sports equipment	Equipment used for physical sport by athletes during practice and/or active gameplay OR equipment necessary to train, practice or participate in athletic or recreational activities.			
Adaptive sports equipment	Any tool, device, or machine used for adaptive sports

Arts & Music Grants

The purpose of this grant opportunity is to increase youth access to art and music education and programming in Hennepin County.

A total of \$300,000 has been allocated for Spring 2025.

Grants up to \$25,000 are available.



Hennepin County

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a local government unit (LGU) located in Hennepin County.
- The majority of individuals benefitting from grant funding must reside within Hennepin County.
- The majority of project participants must be ages 24 years and younger.
- Grant funded projects, services and programming must take place in Hennepin County.



Eligibility (cont.)

- Equipment purchased with grant funds must reside and be stored in Hennepin County.
- Equipment purchased with grant funds may not be kept by individuals.
- Partner organizations and entities receiving grant funds must be registered with the Minnesota Secretary of State.
- Applicant may submit no more than five applications per RFA. If more than five applications are received, all applications may be considered ineligible and rejected as non-responsive.

Term	Definition				
Local Government Unit (LGU)	Municipal districts, public school district, park district, and watershed district located in or operating within Hennepin County.				
Arts and music education and programming	The involvement in youth artistic, musical, and/or creative activities.

Evaluation Criteria

- Ability to generate measurable impacts commensurate with the public investment.
- Demonstration of need for financial assistance.
- Degree to which proposal promotes equal access for all constituents of Hennepin County.
- Degree to which grant funding will benefit populations who reside in areas that have been underserved.
- Degree to which proposed costs are reasonable and necessary.






- All grant information and application materials are on the <u>Hennepin County</u> <u>Supplier Portal</u>

Grant Award Process






Post-Award: Contracts

- Contract drafting, negotiation, and execution
 - HCYAG Contract Manager & Program Staffs
 - Grant agreements identify additional requirements including term lengths (1-3 years), site visits, reporting, signage, and grant budget



Post-Award: Site Visits

- Site visits may be conducted for the following grant projects:
 - Play areas
 - Arts & music
 - Lifeguard services
 - Other projects, as needed
- Notify HCYAG of any special events such as ribbon cuttings, grand openings, or performances.






Post-Award: Invoicing and Payments

- Cost-reimbursement contracts
- LGUs encouraged to create a system to track expenditures
- Complete custom invoice template provided and submit to <u>Youth.Grants@hennepin.us</u> with proof of expenditure and payment for budget line items
