You will work with a care coordinator (formerly known as a case manager) to respond to the specific needs of your child and family. With the care coordinator, you will develop a vision for success and a care plan. You will also develop a support network. We want to help you access the right level of support, at the right time and intensity, to best meet the needs of your child and family.

High Fidelity Wraparound is an evidence-based service model and a core service pillar of System of Care.

Who we serve

Hennepin County children and youth, between the ages of 6 and 18, along with their families.

Children or youth must have a Severe Emotional Disturbance determined by a Diagnostic Assessment within the past 180 days.

Details and contact information

Meetings may take place in your home, in the community, or virtually. Services last an average of 9 to 12 months.

The program is funded through Medical Assistance, Prepaid Medical Assistance Program providers, and Hennepin County for uninsured or privately insured youth.

Three providers deliver High Fidelity Wraparound services in Hennepin County. Families can choose the best fit for their needs.
