

Follow-up information about the ERPOs that have were filed between Jan. 1 and Feb. 9 (the first six weeks that the ERPO laws were in effect).

- 14 ERPO cases filed:
 - 8 cases: the court granted all requested ERPO relief
 - 6 cases: both Emergency & Long-Term ERPOs were granted
 - 2 cases: an Emergency ERPO was granted and no Long-Term ERPO was requested
 - 2 cases: the court granted emergency ERPO relief and hearings are pending
 - 4 cases: the court denied relief, granted partial relief, and/or the petition was withdrawn
 - 1 case: an Emergency ERPO was granted, a hearing was held, and a Long-Term ERPO was denied
 - 1 case: an Emergency ERPO was denied and the petition was withdrawn
 - 1 case: an Emergency ERPO was granted, but petitioner withdrew before the hearing
 - 1 case: an Emergency ERPO was granted, a motion to dismiss was filed; the Emergency order was vacated and the case dismissed
