Street Construction Continues at NorthPoint

NorthPoint's campus will continue to be impacted by Hennepin County and the City of Minneapolis street construction at the intersection of Penn & Plymouth through July. Access to the clinic parking lot will continue, and additional parking will be available in the 1256 Penn parking ramp. The ramp entrance is at Plymouth & Oliver. Walkways to enter NorthPoint will remain accessible during construction, and Metro Transit lines using Penn & Plymouth Avenue will relocate to nearby streets.

Please allow yourself extra time to get to the clinic. For everyone's safety, we ask that you obey all posted speed limits and follow the signs to get to the clinic or parking ramps.

COVID Symptoms
