Application timeline	Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis until Monday, November 14, 2022 or until available funds are depleted.
Amount of funding available	 Applicants may apply for up to \$50,000 Minimum of \$5,000 per project
Matching funds	Grants over \$10,000 require a 25% match
Project timeline	Grant term of up to 18 months.
Reporting requirements	Must submit a final project report at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the grant agreement. The report must detail efforts made to achieve project goals and the results of those efforts, including quantitative data, referencing the baseline data and project expenditures. A reporting template will be provided
